# WELCOME

Dear friends and fellow philatelists

Welcome to sale 43 beginning with Michael Bewick's Regionals collection. This lifelong collection includes many cylinder blocks bought at the time of issue and are now virtually unobtainable, interspersed with many errors and varieties such as lot 133, the set of five British Journey trial printings (cat £13,750 in Pierron) estimated at £1,500. There are also many missing phosphors and unusual artwork and designers pieces. The collections are worth viewing carefully as there are good items, as well as masses of 'face value'.

The rest of the world auction will begin at 3pm after the Regional's section, and we have obtained a marvellous selection of collections and estates, with a high proportion of British Commonwealth. It will begin with lot 189, a valuable four-box estate, and other Br CW collections and stocks will keep you busy viewing for hours.

We had had a bit of a summer clearout and there are over 50 lots in our unreserved section, either bulky lots we have to sell or lots that have somehow been left on the shelves over the previous 12 months. In most cases, these lots fetch over our estimates but they will all be sold, whatever the price.

Amongst the other collections are some real gems such as lot 390, the original Boer War early 1900s South Africa postal history collection with many unusual and attractive covers, gold coins and a lovely coin collection lots 423-428 and many fine one-country lots with prominent Australia, New Zealand, Malaya including Japanese Occupation, British Africa, the West Indies and more.

Also being offered are some fine and rare singles with notable Australia Roos including lot 487 the 1913 £1 Roo with Broken Tail and colour shift, Brunei overprint varieties, China 1962 Mai Lan-Fang miniature sheet and the imperforate sets used, the scarce Guatemala Quetzal Bird 5c inverted centre, Leeward Is 1897 Jubilee First Day covers, Rhodesia Double Heads and so much more.

We are expecting this auction to be very busy, so please contact us early if you wish to come and view at our office. I am pleased to say we have built a new storage and viewing area so now there won't be a crowd, but you will need at least a full day to view the boxes properly, so please don't leave it to the last minute.






