# WELCOME

Dear friends and fellow philatelists

Welcome to our 50th sale which, in honour of our half-century, contains many British Commonwealth rarities and fine collections from around the world.

As you can see from the good array of photos, there are some very rare and highly desirable individual stamps on offer, such as the New Hebrides 1908 1d pair lower stamp overprint omitted, only 12 pairs exist. If you are looking for a spectacular talking point in your collection, the Tonga 1897 7½d Head Inverted has to be top of the list, a very small number known and highly prized. From Malaya and States there are plenty of collections and individual high values, such as a fine example of the 1921 \$100 Key Plate showing Broken Crown and Scroll. The basic stamp is very rare, with the variety incredibly rare.

There are plenty of mixed lots and collections, from mint KGVI collections to estates offered by the box ranging in value from £50 to £5,000. In the country sections are some fine used West Indies collections, difficult to find these days, fine collections of Canada with Classics and scarce Large Queen's; also the popular Cape of Good Hope triangulars with some multiples, a lovely Falkland Is collection with plenty of high values including Centenary, excellent France and Colonies with mint 'Sage' Classics, a Gold Coast cover and remarkable postmark collection.

In Great Britain there are nice collections of stamps and covers, penny black ranges and scarce Officials. Then at the back is a good selection of USA collections with rare and popular Newspaper stamps, which are hardly ever seen in this country.

Now the bad news: unfortunately Carol is having a hip replacement early May. This means four weeks recuperation, so please bear with us if we are not as speedy as usual in answering queries and sending scans. We will not be able to scan boxes or bulky albums this time but rest assured your enquiry will be dealt with as quickly as possible. The new hip means Carol will hopefully soon be running around like a spring chicken again just in time for Stampex in September.

We hope there is something for everyone in this sale. If you are coming to our office to view, please note our viewing arrangements below.
